The Anglian Rover Owners Club Two Day Event Tixover Quarry Camping Rules and Regulations Friday 5th to Sunday 7th July 2019

We are camping at this site by kind permission of the land owner and it would be appreciated that the land be treated with respect and consideration. Below are some, hopefully, reasonable rules and regulations for this weekend.

The camp site will open at 4.00pm on Friday 5th July (TBC) and close after the prize giving on Sunday 7th July afternoon.

The camping is free to pre-entrants! All campers will be expected to help out as much as they can.

There will be portable loos on site for the use of both campers and competitors, please feel free to use them but please leave them in a condition that enables others to use them later.

There will not be any water on site.

Please bring enough for your needs.

Please dispose of all waste water, washing, washing up etc. sensitively.

ALL FOUL WATER FROM PERSONAL PORTALOOS etc. MUST BE TAKEN HOME WITH YOU.

Please make sure your camping area is clear from all personal belongings and all rubbish is taken home with you.

Open fires are not allowed apart from the official bonfire. The use of BBQ's and camping stoves is allowed. All waste from these must be taken home with you. Fire extinguishers can be found at the nearest fire point which will be clearly marked.



Camping regs cont...

The speed limit for the entire site is 5 mph. Where possible please leave all vehicles outside of the camping area as this area is relatively small.

Vehicles may only be driven anywhere on site by full DVLA licence holders other than those drivers who do not hold a full DVLA licence and are entering the TRYO trial who may only drive the designated sections at the designated time.

Vehicles may not be driven around the competitive areas except for setting out and the events themselves.

All loud music/activities/generators must end by/be switched off by 11.00pm. Generators can be started after 6.30am.

All dogs must be under control at all times and on a lead. Dog walking off the lead may be permitted well away from the camping area. All dog excrement is to be picked up and disposed of sensitively.
