Title of Event: **BME Timed Trial (Saturday 23rd June 2018)** Supplementary Regulations

AROC will organize a Clubman's status **Timed Trial** on **23rd June 2018 at Tixover Quarry, near Peterborough, Cambridge**. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) , and these Supplementary Regulations.

MSA Permit number 106407

The event is open to all fully elected members of the invited club.

All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership Card and competition license

The programme of the meeting shall be: Scrutineering starts at 10.00.

Signing on closes at 11.45. Marshals briefing at 12.45.

Drivers briefing at 12.00. First vehicle starts at 12.30.

The event will consist of a circular course marked by canes (trial)

Classes and Vehicle Regulations shall be as per the MSA Technical Regulations. Competition numbers on boards shall be fixed to the front of the vehicle. Tires can be from MSA list A, B or C

The maximum entry shall be 30. The minimum entry and class amalgamations shall be as per the AROC Regulations.

Awards will be presented for class Winners and Runners up according to class numbers. **18.30 hrs. at the signing on tent.**

The entry first opens on **1st May 2018** and closes on **21st June 2018**.

The entry fee is **£20. 00**, in the event of cancellation fees will be refunded.

Each timed section will have the maximum allowed completion time stated at the start gate and will be a "U" shape. Times will be measured with stopwatches to the previous whole second. Only one vehicle at a time will be on the timed section. Time cards to be carried by competitors, it is the responsibility of the Competitor to get the card marked. The finish is a "Drive Through Finish". The completion time will be taken when the front of the vehicle passes the canes marking gate No. 1 or "finish". The Competitor must then wait at the finish to collect his completion time from the Start / Finish Marshal. Scoring will be generally in accordance with the MSA Blue Book. Failure to comply with the above regulations will incur a penalty at the discretion of the organisers.
