How are things going?

The camp site should open on Friday 22nd but as yet we are not sure what time. As soon as we know we will pass this information on but keep an eye on the club web site and Face Book, it is unlikely to be before 4pm.

Saturday morning will involve setting up, in particular the Time Trial and Tyro to start about 12.30pm. That's not all. The marquees/tents need erecting along with flags, banners, signage and anything else that crops up.

The Time Trial Rules and Regs are different from ordinary trial Rules and Regs. Primarily the vehicle has to pass MSA CCV scrutineering, the driver must have an MSA competition licence and an approved crash helmet. Please check the relevant ASR's or check with the MSA Blue Book (available on line at www.msauk.org).

The Time Trial is pre-book only.

The Tyro is the second series of the Walker/Wilkinson championship. To be eligible for this championship all drivers **MUST** be a full member of the AROC. Drivers from other clubs can enter but **WILL NOT** be eligible for the championship. Check the Tyro ASR's.

The RTV and CCV needs to be set out during Saturday ready for Sunday. This setup we would like you, the membership, to do. We have run this type of setup before and it works well. Just remember what you have done, where and yes you will be able to drive your sections competitively.
