[1] Announcement

Anglian Rover Owners Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Cross Country (4x4) Trial (untimed) on 21 April 2024 at Barnhill Farm, Whaddon, Milton Keynes, Bucks.

This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

All entrants must produce a valid club membership card of the club in which they belong and their MSUK RS Clubmans licence. These must be presented to the secretary of the meeting at signing on.

Lowest score with most clears will be the winner.

[9] Vehicles Starting Positions

Front hub to be in line with start gate (if CoC chooses to use them) or the 12 gate.

Practicing will not be permitted.

Identification numbers will not be required by the organisers.

[12] Pits Area

Designated Re-fueling area must be used. If any work to be carried out to a vehicle a groundsheet must be used.

[13] Judges of Fact

All marshals and officials will be considered Judges of Fact
