**[1] Announcement**

Anglian Rover Owners Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Cross Country (4x4) Trial (untimed) on 09 June 2024 at Roundhill Woods, Wigginton nr Tring.

**[2] Jurisdiction**

This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

**[3] Permits**

Motorsport UK Permit No(s): 136452  
Route Authorisation No: n/a

**[4] Eligibility**

The event is open to all fully-elected members of AROC, ALRC, CVLRC, P&D LRC, BHCLRC, SROC, Midland ROC, AWDC, BADLRC, SCOR, LRLRC and all Association of Land Rover Club affiliated clubs. All clubs must have MS UK registration.

All entrants must produce a valid club membership card of the club in which they belong and their MSUK RS Clubmans licence. These must be presented to the secretary of the meeting at signing on.

All technical regulations as per the MSUK blue book apply and those of AROC

Drivers must hold a current valid RTA licence appropriate to the vehicle, with the following exception - drivers aged 15 or over may compete provided they have finished four RTV trials and has a passenger who holds a current valid RTA licence, is a member of a MSA registered club and is experienced in cross-country trials. Proof of finishing four RTV's will be required – a signed logbook or MSA upgrade card will be accepted.

**[5] Championships**

The event is a round of the AROC Annual Trials leagues

**[6] Scrutineering/Programme**

Scrutineering starts at 08.30 on 09 June 2024 at Roundhill Woods.

**[7] Event Start**

The event will start at 10.00am

Nature of Start: Once all drivers have attended the drivers briefing.

Any competitor not signed on by 09.45 may be excluded.

**[8] Description of Event**

CCV - Between 5-10 sections no public highway used

Lowest score with most clears will be the winner.

No details of sections will be published

The following classes will apply: -

CCV – Special Class (diff locks & fiddle brakes)

All other vehicles in one class

**[9] Vehicles Starting Positions**

Front hub to be in line with start gate (if CoC chooses to use them) or the 12 gate.

**[10] Practicing Requirements**

Practicing will not be permitted.

**[11] Identification**

Identification numbers will not be required by the organisers.

**[12] Pits Area**

If any work to be carried out to a vehicle a groundsheet must be used.

**[13] Judges of Fact**

All marshals and officials will be considered Judges of Fact

**[14] Television Coverage**

No Television coverage expected

**[15] Awards**

Results will be announced at the end of the event

**[16] Entries**

The maximum number of vehicles to be entered is 25. The maximum entry for the meeting is 30 competitors and the minimum is 5. Should any of the above figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.
